ORAL ORDER

2 09-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Gurua P.S. Case No. 20 of 2012 dated 26.02.2012 registered for the offences punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, three unknown miscreants are alleged to have looted Rs. 7500/-, mobile and motorcycle of the informant on the point of gun.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. The name of the petitioner has surfaced during the course of investigation.



Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged offence. The petitioner has eight criminal antecedents as stated in para-3 of the supplementary affidavit filed on behalf of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 04.01.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Gaya in connection with Gurua P.S. Case No. 20 of 2012, with a condition:-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bonds of the petitioner are liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
