learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has filed the instant application

for grant of regular bail in a case registered for the

offences punishable under Sections 8(c), 21(b) of

N.D.P.S. Act.

3. As per the allegations in the F.I.R., 10.95

grams of a brown sugar (smack)-like narcotic substance

was recovered from the possession of co-accused Sonu

Kumar. During interrogation, he disclosed the name of

the petitioner as the person from whom he had purchased

the said contraband.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no connection whatsoever with the contraband allegedly recovered. No incriminating substance has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner; rather, the brown sugar (smack)-like narcotic substance has been recovered from the possession of co-accused Sonu Kumar, and the petitioner's name surfaced solely on the basis of his confessional statement. It is further submitted that upon conclusion of the investigation, the police have submitted charge-sheet, and the learned Court has already taken cognizance of the offence. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 05.03.2025.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for Bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances



of the case as well as period of custody, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail, **after framing of charge**, in connection with Special Case (NDPS) No. 93 of 2025 arising out of Rupauli P.S. Case No. 08 of 2025 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, N.D.P.S. Act, Purnea, with following condition:-

(i) One of the bailors should be close relative or family member of the petitioner.
