ORAL ORDER

6 11-12-2025 Heard the learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest for the offences alleged under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered in connection with Civil Lines P.S.Case No. 229/2024.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that both the parties have amicably settled their disputes. A copy of the compromise petition has been annexed with the supplementary affidavit. The petitioner has to pay a total amount of Rs. 82,51,000/- through 22 cheques of Rs. 2,50,000/- each at the interval of three months.

4. The learned counsel for the informant submits that



the petitioner is paying the aforesaid amount.

5. Considering the above facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-I, Gaya in connection with Civil Lines P.S.Case No. 229/2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the CrPC/482(2) of the BNSS.

6. The learned court below shall accept the bail bond provisionally and the same shall be confirmed only after payment of the entire money within the stipulated period.
