2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Buxar Mufassil P.S. Case No-275 of 2024, dated-03.09.2024, registered for the offence punishable under Section 64 of the B.N.S., 2023.

3. As per allegation, the wife of the informant was subjected to rape by the Petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. He refers to the evidence which has come during the trial. The Informant as well as the alleged victim has clearly not supported the case of the prosecution against the Petitioner. They have been also declared hostile in view of the evidence of



the Informant and the alleged victim before the Trial Court.

5. He further submits that the petitioner has been languishing in jail since 04.04.2025.

6. It has also been stated in paragraph no. 3 of the bail petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

7. It is also stated in paragraph no. 2 of the bail petition that the petitioner has moved this Court earlier for anticipatory bail vide Cr. Misc. No. 74058 of 2024.

8. However, learned APP for the State vehemently opposes the prayer of the petitioner for bail.

9. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, **this application is allowed**, directing the petitioner, above-named, to be enlarged on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000 /- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned concerned Court below in connection with Buxar Mufassil P.S. Case No-275 of 2024 on the following conditions:

(i) The petitioner will make himself available for interrogation by a police officer/court as and when required.

(ii) The petitioner will undertake that investigation/trial will not get hampered on account of his absence or non-cooperation. He must be available to the police



or the court whenever his presence is required.

(iii) The petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.

(iv) In case, it is brought to the notice of the court below that the petitioner has any criminal antecedents, learned court below shall cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner after hearing him and getting satisfied that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedents despite his knowledge of the same.

(v) In case, it is brought to the notice of the court below that statement regarding previous bail petition is wrong, learned court below shall cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
