party no.4 and 6 and the learned State counsel has taken this Court to the order passed by the Collector, Kishanganj vide memo no. 5839 dated 05.12.2025 by which it has been recorded that he is not entitled to the amount and Kiran Kumar Mandal has also not been given the compensation.

4. In that background, nothing remains, the petitioner if so wants, can challenge the said order.
