ORAL ORDER

4 15-10-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Sherghati P.S. Case No. 494/2024 dated 29.09.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 96, 64, 351(2), 352 read with section 3(5) of the BNS and section 4 of the POCSO Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-accused persons in connivance with one another are alleged to have kidnapped the minor daughter of the informant.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. There is love affair between the petitioner and the victim. The victim in her statement recorded u/s 183 of the BNSS has stated that she herself called the petitioner and thereafter they went to Chennai by train and the victim also solemnized marriage with the petitioner. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 02.11.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Gaya in connection with Sherghati P.S. Case No. 494/2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
