ORAL ORDER

5 04-12-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as complainant and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 1092(C) of 2022, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498(A), 323, 504, 506, 379/34 of the IPC and Sections 3/4 of the D.P. Act.

3. It is a case of matrimonial dispute.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. He is a person of clean antecedent. He has



submitted further that the petitioner is ready to pay Rs. 3,000/- per month as interim maintenance to opposite party no. 2 (complainant).

5. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, especially the fact that the petitioner is ready to pay Rs. 3,000/- per month as interim maintenance to opposite party no. 2, **provisional bail granted vide order dated 04.06.2025 by a co-ordinate Bench of this Hon'ble Court, is hereby confirmed.**

6. **The petitioner is directed to pay Rs. 3,000/- per month as interim maintenance to opposite party no. 2 (the informant). The interim maintenance granted by this Court shall be subject to adjustment, if any other court grants maintenance to the opposite party no. 2.**
