ORAL ORDER

learned A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Gopalganj Excise P.S. Case No. 145 of 2025, dated 05.03.2025 registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 99.000 litres of illicit country made liquor was recovered from the two plastic gunny bags near a pond at the village Badheya.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious



possession of the petitioner and the petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner carries two criminal antecedents out of which one is of similar nature as stated in paragraph no. 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 06.03.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District and Session Judge-IV-cum-Special Excise Judge-II, Gopalganj, in connection with **Gopalganj Excise P.S. Case No. 145 of 2025.**

7. The application stands allowed.
