2 25-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 47 of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 540 litres illicit liquor was
recovered from the seized motorcycles.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no
incriminating material has been recovered from conscious
possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is neither driver nor
owner of the vehicles in question and he has been made accused
only on suspicion. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently
opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the



petitioner.

6. Considering the nature of accusation, fact that no incriminating article has been recovered from conscious possession of this petitioner and clean antecedents, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is allowed.

7. Accordingly, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Court Excise- 2, Nawada in connection with Nawada Excise P.S. Case No. 62 of 2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S..
