ORAL ORDER

2 13-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Koransarai P.S. Case No. 91 of 2024 dated 12.10.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 179 read with section 3 (5) of B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, the co-accused persons were apprehended with the counterfeit currency notes worth Rs. 7000/-.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The other co-accused person has already been granted bail by this court *vide* order dated 17.02.2025 passed in Cr.



Misc. No. 87391/2024. The apprehended person disclosed the name of the petitioner. No incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has one antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 26.03.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner by submitting that the apprehended person disclosed that the said fake notes were given to him by the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Buxar in connection with Koransarai P.S. Case No. 91 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
