3 19-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Samastipur (Town) P.S. Case No. 251 of 2024 instituted for the
offences under Sections 310(2), 310(4), 311 of the Bharatiya
Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that five unknown
persons looted Rs. 5,70,000/- from the shop of the informant on
gunpoint.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the



petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner transpired in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Sonu Sahani. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner has got no concern with the looted articles. Learned counsel further submitted that T.I.P. has not been conducted till date. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 20.12.2024 and has one criminal antecedent. The co-accused person has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 30.07.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 47004 of 2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, claim based on parity as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court
