- 2 18-06-2025 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
APP for the State and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of
the informant.
2. The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his
arrest in Lodipur P. S. Case No.149 of 2024 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 406, 420 and 506 of the
Indian Penal Code.
3. The learned A.P.P., at the outset, submits that the
offences for which the instant FIR has been instituted carries
punishment of seven years and less the said submission is not
disputed by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner and the informant, as such, the learned A.P.P. submits
that the case be disposed of in terms of order dated 13.02.2024



in Cr. Misc. No.3536 of 2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. the State of Bihar) as investigation in the case is still continuing.

4. At this stage, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the informant submits that the petitioner was issued notice under Section 41(A) of the Cr.P.C., but then, the reason best known the petitioner chose not to appear and has moved before this Court seeking anticipatory bail when the offences for which the instant FIR has been instituted carries punishment of seven years and less.

5. At this stage, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the anticipatory bail application with liberty to avail his remedy in accordance with law.

6. Permission is accorded.

7. Accordingly, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
