ORAL ORDER

2 24-06-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for
grant of regular bail in connection with Sangrampur P.S. Case
No. 66 of 2025 dated 23.02.2025 registered for the offences
punishable u/s 30(a), 32 and 41(1) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 90 litres of illicit
country made liquor was recovered from the Gandak Diyar and
600 litre of pass was also found and destroyed on the spot.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged



recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is submitted that local chowkidar disclosed the name of the petitioner. The petitioner has two criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 06.04.2025

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, in connection with Sangrampur P.S. Case No. 66 of 2025.

7. This application is allowed.
