ORAL ORDER

2 01-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Sirisiya P.S. Case No. 34/2025 dated 21.02.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 309(6), 61(2), 352, 351(2) of the BNS.

3. As per the prosecution case, it is alleged that the informant submitted Rs. 15,00,000/- as advance money to the co-accused Harendra Prasad for the business of the Cash Gold Pan Masala, thereafter, the informant was sent to jail in a case. When the informant was released on bail, he went to the co-accused Harendra Prasad and demanded the goods for the



advanced money but the co-accused denied. On 20.02.2025, the informant again demanded either goods or the amount which he submitted as an advance but the co-accused again denied it. When the informant was returning, in the meantime, unknown miscreants dashed him from the motorcycle, put chilli powder in his eyes and stabbed him in the chest and leg and they also snatched Rs. 45,000/- a golden chain worth Rs. 95,000/- and his mobile phone.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. The name of the petitioner has sprung up during the course of the investigation. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. There is nothing against the petitioner except suspicion. The petitioner has two criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 26.02.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond



of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Sirisiya P.S. Case No. 34/2025, with the condition/s:-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
