ORAL ORDER

2 24-06-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for
grant of regular bail in connection with Pahleja P.S. Case No. 39
of 2024 dated 30.04.2024 registered for the offence punishable
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 30 litres of
illicit country made liquor was recovered from a bush behind
transformer at the village Alipur, Diara.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious



possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner was not apprehended from the spot and name of petitioner transpired on the basis of disclosure made by villagers. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent of similar nature as stated in paragraph no. 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 24.05.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Exclusive Special Excise Judge, Saran at Chapra, in connection with **Pahleja P.S. Case No. 39 of 2024.**

7. The application stands allowed.
