2 30-06-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
the State .

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Section 30(a) , 32 (3) of Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

3 . As per prosecution case , 86.4 liters foreign liquor
was recovered from the seized vehicle of which this petitioner is
registered owner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no
incriminating material has been recovered from conscious
possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has got no concern with
the alleged recovery and he has been made accused in this case
only on suspicion . Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5 . Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for



bail of the petitioner and submits that petitioner is registered owner of the seized vehicle .

6. Considering the huge quantity of recovery and also the fact that petitioner is owner of the seized vehicle , prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is refused.
