ORAL ORDER

2 30-06-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Barachatti P.S. Case No. 857 of 2022 instituted for the offences
under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that, on 21.09.2022,
the informant after collecting Rs. 48,050/- was on his way and
in the meantime, he was accosted with three miscreants who
snatched the entire amount on the point of pistol.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case.
Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner
transpired in this case during investigation. No incriminating
article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the
petitioner. Learned counsel further submitted that T.I.P. has not



been conducted till date. Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner has got no concern with the looted amount. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 05.03.2025 and has no criminal antecedent. The co-accused person has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 18.06.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 36725 of 2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, claim based on parity as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Barachatti P.S. Case No. 857 of 2022.
