learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 120(B),
302 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25(1-b)a, 26, 27 and
35 of the Arms Act.

3. Vide order dated 22.11.2024, a report was called
for from the learned Court below regarding the stage of trial and
the time likely to be taken in conclusion of the trial. In
compliance thereof, a report dated 28.11.2024 has been sent by
the learned Additional Sessions Judge 20th, Muzaffarpur, which
is kept on record. In his report, the learned Judge has, *inter alia*,
stated that the trial is likely to be concluded within period of
three months.



4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the report of the Trial Court, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail. The prayer for regular bail of the petitioner is hereby rejected in connection with Sahebganj P.S. Case No. 72 of 2022.
