At the outset, it is pointed out that the number of the orders dated 23.10.2024 and 09.01.2025 have inadvertently been typed as '56' and '57' respectively in place of order Nos. '6' and '7'.

2. Let the number of the aforesaid orders be read as '6' and '7' respectively.

3. The orders dated 23.10.2024 and 09.01.2025 are modified to the extent indicated above.
