3 03-09-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Birpur
P.S. Case No. 265 of 2024 registered for the offence punishable
under Sections 21(c), 25 and 29 of the NDPS Act.

3. The recovery is of 241 piece bottles of eskuf cough
syrup of 100 ml each which has been recovered from the
motorcycle of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this
case. The petitioner is in custody since 24.07.2024 and claims
clean antecedent.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State opposes the
prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.



6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge NDPS-cum- District and Additional Sessions Judge-V, Supaul/ concerned Court in connection with Birpur P.S. Case No. 265 of 2024, subject to the condition that both the bailors should be the blood relative of the petitioner.

7. The petitioner will also mark attendance in Birpur Police Station District- Supaul on every Sunday of the month. Any default in appearance at the Police Station would result in cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner.

8. At the time of accepting bail bonds of the petitioner, the Court below will verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner. If it is found that the petitioner has criminal antecedent, the Court below shall not accept the bail bonds of the petitioner and if it is found that the petitioner has clean antecedent, his bail bonds shall be accepted by the Court below.
