2 07-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per F.I.R., 25 liters of country-made liquor has been recovered in abandoned condition near the railway track.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of petitioner and has been implicated in this case only on suspicion. The petitioner has got one criminal antecedent of similar nature.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.



6. Considering the aforesaid facts & circumstances, let the above named petitioner, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Judge Excise-II, Saharsa, in connection with Saharsa Sadar P.S. Case No. 288/2025, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
