learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with

Nagra P.S. Case No. 50 of 2025 registered for the offence under

Sections 310(4), 310(5) of the B.N.S. and Section 25(1-b)a,

26(2) and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner is

accused of planning loot. The petitioner along with co-accused

was caught. One country made pistol has been recovered from

the co-accused. Nothing has been recovered from the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the

petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. The

petitioner is in custody since 03.04.2025.



5. Learned A.P.P. appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this application for regular bail is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate-1st Class, Saran, Chapra/concerned Court below in connection with Nagra P.S. Case No. 50 of 2025 subject to condition that:-

“(i) One of the bailors will be his own blood relative, preferably, father, mother, brother, sister and/or his wife.

(ii) The petitioner will mark his attendance at the Marhawarah Police Station on the every Sunday of each month. Any default in appearance at the Police Station would result in cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner.”

8. This application for regular bail stands allowed.
