**ORAL ORDER**

3      04-09-2025                      Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and  
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with  
Rauhi P.S. Case No. 453 of 2024 registered for the offence  
under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 125(a), 76, 351(2), 3(5) of the  
B.N.S. and Sections 8 and 12 of the POCSO Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner is  
accused of molesting the victim.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner is innocent and has not committed any offence. The  
petitioner is in custody since 15.01.2025 and he claims clean  
antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. appearing for the State has  
vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the



case, this application for regular bail is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 7<sup>th</sup> Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge POCSO Act, Bihar Sharif at Nalanda/concerned Court below in connection with Rahui P.S. Case No. 453 of 2024 subject to condition that:-

*(i). The petitioner will mark his attendance at the Rahui Police Station on the first and the last Sunday of each month. Any default in appearance at the Police Station would result in cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner.*

*(ii). Before accepting the bail-bond of the petitioner, the court below will verify the antecedent of the petitioner. If the petitioner is found having clean antecedent, the bail-bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted. If the petitioner is found having criminal antecedent(s), his bail-bonds shall not be accepted by the court below.*

8. This application for regular bail stands allowed.
