ORAL ORDER

2 03-07-2025 Having regard to the fact that the petitioner had already filed his objections before the Certificate Officer, the present writ petition is disposed of directing the Certificate Officer to pass necessary orders under Section 10 of the Act duly taking into consideration the objections filed by the petitioner.

2. It is needless to observe that before passing any



order, the Certificate Officer shall give an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. The entire exercise should be completed as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Any order passed shall be communicated to the parties.

3. Till such time, the final order is passed, the authority is directed not to take any coercive steps against the petitioner. In case the petitioner does not cooperate for the disposal of the case, the authority is free to pass necessary final orders in accordance with law.
