ORAL ORDER

2 15-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Jamui
P.S. Case No. 762 of 2024 instituted for the offence under
Section 309(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. Prosecution case in a nutshell is that informant was
accosted by two miscreants who snatched his bag containing Rs.
20,000/- and fled away.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 19-04-2025. Petitioner
bears one criminal antecedent, as per disclosure made in
paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's



counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. Name of the petitioner has transpired on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused, namely, Falguni Yadav. No recovery is made from possession of the petitioner. Petitioner was not even put on T.I. Parade. Police after completion of investigation has submitted charge sheet in this case.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner, manner of petitioner's implication and charge sheet being submitted, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Jamui P.S. Case No. 762 of 2024.
