2      09-07-2025                      1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and  
learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case  
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148,  
149, 188, 341, 323, 353, 307 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that  
petitioner has antecedent of three cases and from perusal of the  
allegation as alleged in the FIR, it would manifest that no  
specific allegation is alleged against the petitioner. It is further  
submitted that similarly situated co-accused, namely, Amir Khan  
@ Md. Amir Khan and Manjeet Chaudhary @ Sanjeet  
Chaudhary @ Sanjit Choudhary had approached this Court  
seeking anticipatory bail by filing Cr. Misc. No. 35239 of 2025  
and Cr. Misc. No. 17776 of 2023 and the same was allowed by a  
learned Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated



29.05.2025 and 25.05.2023 respectively. It is next submitted that allegation is that accused persons were raising slogans against Agnipath Scheme and were burning tyres on road on account of which there was a traffic jam.

4. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

5. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, let the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Belaganj P.S. Case No. 297 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
