ORAL ORDER

2 21-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Tikapatti P.S. Case No. 66 of 2025 dated 29.04.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 20(b)(ii)(b) of the NDPS Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 4.56 kgs of Ganja was recovered from the house of the co-accused Nand Kishore Mandal and he also confessed that the petitioner brought the said Ganja from Manipur, thereafter at his instances, the petitioner was apprehended.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. The seized contraband is below the commercial quantity. The said recovery was made from the house of the co-accused Nand Kishore Mandal. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 13.05.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner by submitting that the petitioner had no any valid authorization for keeping the said contraband.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Purnea in connection with Tikapatti P.S. Case No. 66 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
