ORAL ORDER

2 16-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Hasanpur P.S. Case No. 26 of 2025, dated 13.02.2025 registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 135.150 litres of illicit Indian made foreign liquor was recovered from the bamboo orchard.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case merely on the basis of suspicion. Nothing has been



recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner, rather the recovery has been made from an open place which is accessible to one and all. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has got two criminal antecedents as stated in paragraph no. 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 18.05.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Judge, Excise-I, Samastipur, in connection with **Hasanpur P.S. Case No. 26 of 2025.**

7. The application stands allowed.
