2. The present petition has been filed for cancellation
of anticipatory bail granted to the Opposite Party Nos. 2 to 4 by
the learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII, Danapur in
connection with Complaint Case No. 1514 of 2023 under
Sections 406, 420 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 138 of
Negotiable Instrument Act.



3. It appears that the petitioner without approaching the concerned court who has granted bail to the Opposite Party Nos. 2 to 4 has directly approached this Hon’ble Court.
