The petitioners, two in number, have filed this writ petition for setting aside the order as contained in Letter No. 22 dated 14.10.2022 issued by Member Secretary, Panchayat Employment Committee-cum-Panchayat Secretary, Gram Panchayat Raj, Karup, Block-Sasaram, District-Rohtas dispensing with the services of the petitioners as Panchayat Teacher.

3. Since the petitioners are Panchayat Teacher, in view
