State .

2. Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 147, 149, 148, 341 , 323 , 324, 307, 325 , 354 A , 379, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code .



3 . As per the prosecution case , on the alleged date and time of occurrence , these petitioners along with other co-accused persons came at the field of the informant and assaulted the informant and others due to which four persons sustained injury .

4. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that there was a land dispute between the parties and on the alleged date and time of occurrence , prosecution party forcibly tried to capture the land due to which a simple occurrence of mararpeet took place between the parties in which both sides sustained injury . Case and counter case . Allegation of assault is general and omnibus and there is no specific overt act is alleged against these petitioners. Similarly situated co-accused persons have already granted bail by this Court vide order dated 09.09.2024 in Cr. Misc. No. 46525 of 2024 . Petitioners claim clean antecedent.

5 . Learned counsel for the State oppose the bail petition .

6 Considering the fact that allegation of assault is general and omnibus against these petitioners , clean antecedent of the petitioners and other circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within eight weeks from today, let



the petitioners, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM VI Danapur in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 179 of 2024 , subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure .
