A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offence under Sections 303, 111(2)(ii), 111(3), 111(4), 111(5), 112(2) of B.N.S., 2023, Section 21 of MM (D&R) Act, 1957 and Rule 56 of BM (CPIMTS) Rules, 2024.

3. It is alleged that F.I.R. named accused persons including this petitioner were engaged in illegal mining and transportation of sand.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was labourer and was working on the instruction of employer. No incriminating article has been recovered from possession of this petitioner and is in custody since 17.02.2025. Charge-sheet has been submitted.



5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the bail petition.

6. Considering the period of custody, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Gaya / concerned Court in connection with Fatehpur P.S. Case No. 683 of 2024.
