3. By means of this writ petition, the petitioner has

challenged the order dated 05.60.2025 bearing Memo No. 1526

issued by the Director, Primary Education, Government of

Bihar, Patna/ respondent No. 3 whereby the petitioner's services as Panchayat Teacher at Primary School, Gachi Tola, Bela Simari, District-Khagaria has been terminated and by which order it has been stated that the respondent No. 11 has a better claim.
