ORAL ORDER

4 09-01-2025 At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners

seeks permission to withdraw the anticipatory bail application

with regard to petitioner No. 1 .

2. Permission is granted.

3 . The anticipatory bail application with regard to
petitioner No. 1 is, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn .

4. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Nos. 2 and
3 and the State.

5 . Petitioner Nos. 2 and 3 apprehend arrest in a case



registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341 , 342, 323 , 354 B, 379, 504 and 34 of Indian Penal Code .

6. As per prosecution case , on the alleged date and time of occurrence , all the accused persons including these petitioners came to the house of informant and assaulted informant and others due to which they sustained injury .

7. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per F.I.R., specific accusation of assault is against co-accused Sanjeet Yadav. So far as, these petitioners are concerned, there is no allegation of any overt act against them. Petitioners claim clean antecedent.

8 . Learned counsel for the informant vehemently opposed the bail application .

9. Considering the fact that there is no allegation of any overt act against these petitioners , clean antecedent of these petitioners and other circumstances this anticipatory bail is allowed and it is ordered that let the above named petitioner Nos. 2 and 3 in the event of their arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate Darbhanga in



connection with Darbhanga Sadar (Mabbi OP) P. S. Case No.
107 of 2024 , subject to condition as laid down under Section
438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure .
