2 04-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Bidupur P.S. Case No. 783 of 2024, registered under Sections
304 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and later on Sections
309(4) and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 were
added.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that, while the
informant was on his way along with his wife, two unknown
miscreants came on motorcycle and snatched the purse
containing Rs. 5,000/- and two gold rings as also mobile from
his wife and fled away.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the



petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. Name of the petitioner has transpired in this case on the basis of confessional statement made by co-accused, namely, Rahul Kumar and Sagar Kumar and the same has got no evidentiary value. It is next submitted that the alleged recovery of looted articles have been made from the possession of co-accused, namely, Rahul Kumar. The petitioner has got two criminal antecedents in which he is on bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that similarly situated co-accused has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 16.04.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 20310 of 2025.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Bidupur P.S. Case No. 783 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under



Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita,
2023.
