ORAL ORDER

4 13-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Motihari Muffasil P.S. Case No. 200 of 2024 dated 30.04.2024 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 25(1-B)(a), 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, one country-made pistol, one live cartridge and a motorcycle were recovered from the possession of the co-accused, Sunil Sahani and the petitioner succeeded to flee away from the place of occurrence.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The apprehended co-accused, Sunil Sahani disclosed the name of the petitioner. Nothing has been recovered from the



conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged occurrence. The petitioner has nine criminal antecedents in which he is on bail in eight criminal cases as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 03.04.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Motihari Muffasil P.S. Case No. 200 of 2024, with a condition:-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bonds of the petitioner are liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
