3. In case of non-execution of the Process issued by

any court, it is for the court which has issued the process to take

steps to ensure that the Authorities which are duty bound to



execute the Process, discharge their duties. Hence, the petitioner should move the court for execution of the Process issued against Respondent No. 5.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to move the court who has issued the Process in question against Respondent No. 5.
