2. With the consent of the parties, the present writ application is being disposed of at this stage itself.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for seeking the relief as claimed for in the present writ application, the petitioner is prepared to file a detailed representation before the Municipal Commissioner, Patna Municipal Corporation, Patna for which some time may be granted. He further prays that if such a representation is filed, the Municipal Commissioner, Patna be directed to dispose of the said representation within a fixed time frame after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, by passing a reasoned and speaking order.

4. The aforesaid prayer being made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is not opposed by the Respondents.

5. Considering the limited nature of prayer being made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this writ application is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed representation before the Municipal Commissioner, Patna Municipal Corporation, Patna within two weeks from the date of passing of this order. If such a representation is filed by the petitioner before the Municipal Commissioner, Patna, the Municipal Commissioner, Patna shall dispose of the said



representation on merit after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, by passing a reasoned and speaking order.

6. The entire exercise must be completed by the Municipal Commissioner, Patna within a period of two months from the date of filing representation by the petitioner.

7. With the aforesaid direction/observation, the present writ application stands disposed of.
