ORAL ORDER

2 29-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Derni P.S. Case No. 71 of 2025 dated 17.04.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 84 litres of illicit country made liquor was recovered from the blue colour Scooty.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not the owner rather he is the rider of the said vehicle as stated in para-8 of the bail petition. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has



been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has four criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 19.04.2025. The co-accused person has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 14.07.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 44009 of 2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Saran at Chapra in connection with Derni P.S. Case No. 71 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
