ORAL ORDER

2 15-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Sadar Excise P.S. Case No. 168of 2025 dated 15.05.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/ss Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act, 2018.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 52.665 litres of Nepali country made liquor was recovered from two boxes in possession of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case on suspicion. Petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner rather the seized liquor was recovered from an open place which does not belong to the petitioner. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 16.05.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned/Exclusive Special Judge, Excise Judge, Madhubani in connection with Sadar Excise P.S. Case No. 168 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
