2. Petitioner has *inter alia* prayed for following reliefs

in the paragraphs No.1 of the writ petition:-

“That the petitioner prays for issuance of an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions to the respondents for payment of regular salary and further prays for regularization of the service of the petitioner on the class III post as clerk against the existing vacant and sanctioned post in the college.

submitted that petitioner seeks to file a detailed representation for redressal of his grievance before respondent no.4, the Vice-Chancellor, Bhim Rao Ambedkar, Bihar University, Muzaffarpur in light of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the cases of ***Jaggo Vs. Union of India & Ors. (SLP (C) No. 5580 of 2024); Vinod Kumar and Ors. Etc. Vs. Union of India & Ors.***, reported in ***(2024) 1 S.C.R. 1230*** and ***Shripal & Anr. vs. Nagar Nigam, Ghaziabad (Civil Appeal Nos. 8158-8179 of 2024)***.
