Learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the respondent-State are present.

2. Learned counsel, Mr. Indu Bhushan, junior counsel to Mr. Vidya Sagar, Advocate appears for the petitioner and submits that the cases have become infructuous and, therefore, he is under instruction to withdraw the same.
