ORAL ORDER

2 16-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Jhanjharpur Excise P.S. Case No. 82 of 2025 dated 21.05.2025 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 32(1) and 32(3) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 72 litres of illicit Nepali country made liquor was recovered from the motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case merely on the basis of suspicion. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The



petitioner is neither owner nor driver of the motorcycle in question. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has got three criminal antecedents as stated in paragraph no. 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 21.05.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Jhanjharpur, Madhubani, in connection with **Jhanjharpur Excise P.S. Case No. 82 of 2025.**

7. The application stands allowed.
