APP for the State.

2.The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Buxar (Mahila) P.S. Case No. 22 of 2025 instituted for the offence under Sections 69, 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S. Act, 2023.

3. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners, who are parents of Shani Kumar have threatened her with dire consequences while she came out of the police station after registering a complaint against their son.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence. They have falsely been implicated in this case. He also submits that the only allegation against the



petitioners are that they have threatened. The main thrust of allegation is against petitioner's son namely, Shani Kumar. It has lastly been submitted that a statement has been made in para-3 of this petition that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

5. In contra, learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioners and submits that there is an allegation that the petitioners have threatened the victim of dire consequences.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The petitioners are directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender in connection with Buxar (Mahila) P.S. Case No. 22 of 2025, they will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Buxar, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S.
