ORAL ORDER

2 28-07-2025 Heard Mr. Ravi Ranjan, learned counsel for the
petitioner and Ms. Renu Kumari, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Muzaffarpur Excise PS Case No. 679 of 2025 instituted for the
offences under Sections 30(a) and 32(3) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that total 227.8
litres of foreign liquor was recovered out of which 150.040
litres of liquor was recovered from Haystack behind the house
of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from
the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got



no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. It is submitted that recovery is made from an open place, which is accessible to one and all. The petitioner is in custody since 03.06.2025 and has got no criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 103 of B.N.S.S.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, clean antecedent of the petitioner and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Muzaffarpur Excise PS Case No. 679 of 2025.
