In view of the aforesaid, the impugned pay verification certificate issued vide Receipt No. 1707221200021 , under the signature of the authorized officer, Pay Verification Cell, Department of Education, Government of Bihar, Patna (Annexure-P/8) is hereby quashed and the matter is remanded back to the State authorities for proceeding afresh in accordance with law.
