4 11-02-2025 Without going into the merits or demerits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to either file an application to set aside the *ex parte* order passed by the Debts Recovery Tribunal or file an appeal against the *ex parte* order before the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal, Allahabad as he deems fit.

2. The petitioner is permitted to approach the Debts Recovery Tribunal within a period of four weeks from today and



the Hon’ble Debts Recovery Tribunal shall endeavour to dispose of the application filed by the petitioner within a period of eight weeks thereof.

3. With the aforesaid liberty, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
