ORAL ORDER

2 11-08-2025 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well
as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection
with Amas P.S. Case No. 123 of 2025, registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 317(5), 318(4), 336(3), 338,
3(5) of the BNS.

3. According to allegation, the petitioner and his
friend were using the stolen vehicle after changing its number
plate.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. He has further submitted that the recovered
motorcycle did not belong to the petitioner, but to his friend. He
has also submitted that the petitioner is a person of clean



antecedent and is under custody since 27.04.2025.

5. On the other hand, the learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above-named, is directed to furnish bail bond and on doing so, the court below shall release the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate-Ist Class, Sherghati at Gaya in connection with Amas P.S. Case No. 123 of 2025, subject to the following conditions that the petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.

7. Before accepting the bail bond, the learned court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and if it is found that he is involved in any other case except the present one, his bail bond shall not be accepted.
