2. The present petition has been preferred for the
following relief(s):

*“for issuance of an appropriate
writ/writs, order/ orders, direction/ directions for
quashing the order dated 20.05.2025 passed in
Mutation Case No. 7513R27/2024-25 by the Circle
Officer, Sadar, Gaya whe4reby and where under
the application of Mutation of petitioner of the part*
