ORAL ORDER

2 29-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Singhwara P.S. Case No. 82 of 2025 dated 10.04.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 318(4) of the B.N.S. and u/s 30(a)(c)(d)(e)(g), 33 and 36 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 89.25 litres of illicit foreign liquor along with raw materials of manufacturing of liquor were recovered from the house of the co-accused, Vivek Kumar Mishra. It is further alleged that four motorcycles were also recovered from the place of occurrence.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted



that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused, Vivek Kumar Mishra. The petitioner is the owner of one of the seized vehicles but he has no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has two criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 29.05.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Darbhanga in connection with Singhwara P.S. Case No. 82 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
